Group transportation to tree-planting site

These trees will act as a natural filtration for a cleaner Maumee River and restore the beauty of the area. The property is being restored from frequently flooded farmland within the river's floodplain to natural habitats. Rotary Club funding along with District Grant totaled \$36,000 to enhance this project being completed by the Conservancy and the H2Ohio program.

The location is between Napoleon and Grand Rapids, Ohio, on the north side of the Maumee River. It is immediately west of a railroad bridge, and is currently referred to as the Maumee River Floodplain Property.

6,000 of the saplings will surround 600 bigger trees which will be bagged to ensure they survive.
